President's Report

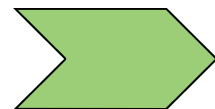

There appears to be a lot of controversy going around among ATFTC club members regarding the Cover Letter/Ballot that was sent out requesting their input as to whether or not they are interested in having the BOD establish a CB&L's Revision Committee. I would like to try and clear up at least some of these issues.

First off, this issue was originally raised at the Annual Meeting in Las Vegas, NV at last year's Nationals. It was brought up from the floor and not by the BOD when I expressed a desire that the members tell the BOD what they were interested in us addressing. At that time I requested that anyone interested in volunteering for such a committee to please so advise the Secretary. At that point, there were several members who immediately volunteered - BJ Andrews, Denise Monette, Vickie Kerley, Kasey Mando and Sondra Kendall.

There was never any Motion made to set up this committee during either that meeting or any subsequent BOD meetings. While this can be verified via the minutes for the BOD meetings, it unfortunately cannot be verified via the minutes for the Annual Meeting as our current CB&L's clearly state that these cannot be approved (and therefore posted) until the following Annual Meeting. Perhaps this is one of the areas that could benefit from CB&L revisions as I do not know that it is either reasonable or logical to have the members approving said minutes relying on their memories from a year ago. As well based on the past Nationals, you can be sure it is not always the same group of members that attend the Annual Meetings. While we have a recording of the proceedings from which the minutes have been prepared, It has also been implied that I am personally the one who is requesting these revisions. It has also been implied that I have something personal to gain from same. I would like to clearly state here that I am not now, nor have I ever been personally in favor of either the formation of this committee or the current revisions of the CB&Ls nor can I figure out how I could possibly benefit from same. It is not that I feel the current CB&L's are perfect as they are, but rather that the BOD time may be better utilized in other areas at this time.

This is why I did, however, support the current letter/ballot being sent physically to each member of the ATFTC. I intend the BOD to be very clear on whether the membership as a whole supports this or not. I also feel it important to have the physical evidence of same for anyone to review. Yes, this was not an inconsiderable expense, but with something as basic to the club as the CB&L's, I felt it was appropriate. This was put before and agreed upon by the BOD. This can be seen in the April BOD meeting minutes as item #3 under "Unfinished Business".



In a response made by the Secretary to an email question from one of the ATFTC members, she stated that 2 separate Parliamentarians had commented on the inadequacies of our CB&L's. These individuals were located via a Parliamentarian Referral Website and contacted by the Secretary in regards to handling last year's BOD Elections. Both reviewed the CB&L's, the first one did not have the time to handle this project in the time frame required, the second one is the individual who did handle our election. Neither of these individuals is personally known by any of the current BOD members.

As it was correctly stated by a current ATFTC member on Face Book, the BOD is not to communicate official club business via any Social Media sites. The only official internet presence is the ATFTC website and the monthly ATFTC publications. However, anyone at anytime can contact any one of us with their questions or concerns. I would like to thank those ATFTC members who took it upon themselves to do so.

As for the mailing itself, as with the Ballots for the 2013 BOD elections, some were received shortly after being mailed, some took much longer to arrive and some, apparently, were never delivered. Again, these were ALL mailed to ALL ATFTC members at the same time. I am quite sure that this is not the only USPS delivery that anyone has ever had an issue with. To accuse the current Secretary of selectively sending out said ballots makes very little sense as it is obvious that a number of those who HAVE received the ballots are not in favor of this committee. If you have NOT received your ballot by now, please contact the Secretary immediately for another packet.

Here's hoping that each of you had a wonderful Mother's Day and that Spring and Summer finally comes to all!
