Susan Thibodeaux made a Facebook announcement that Laura Johnson has taken over as Chair of the Meet The Breeds Committee.

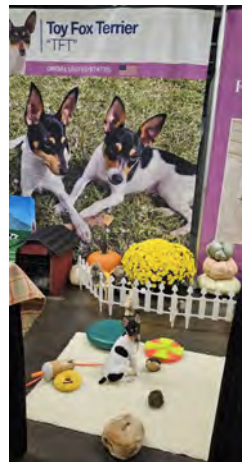
Thank you, Laura!

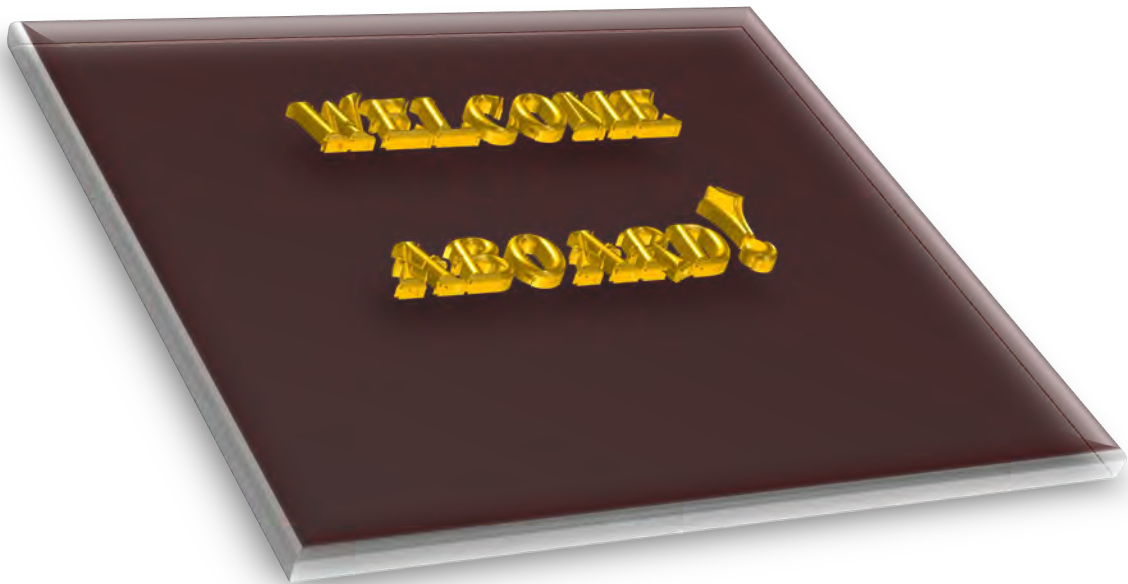

From Rescue to Ribbons

How White Pines Little Shaunee (Shaun) went from pit bait rescue to become the first Toy Fox Terrier AKC Rally Obedience titlist.

E (SHAUN)

It was 1999 and I remember the first time I saw him. He was dangerously skinny. Skin stretched tight over bones that jugged out, framing a fragile, bony skeleton. He trembled from head to foot, probably from the draftiness of the concrete cell where he was confined in Animal Control, but also from fear. The globes of his large, luminous eyes rolled up from the cold, wet floor to meet mine. They seemed to expect to find no one there who would help him. He looked like he had lost any reason to hope.

The people at animal control said he'd tried to attack the vet who examined him on intake. He was, therefore, slated to be gassed along with several large, aggressive dogs whose barks thundered down the shelter's hall.

Finding a "yes"

Sometimes, connection to an animal outweighs common sense, and I slid open the iron latch to his cage. The heavy door creaked open and I stretched out my hand. Slowly, gently, I talked to him. His cowered position in the corner cautiously began to relax. Tentatively, he lifted his nose and sniffed.

Oh, Shaun. How grateful I am that you took those first few steps inching slowly toward me. I let him snuffle my fingers. Little by little, he slid his head beneath my touch. Lightly, I stroked the velvety contours of his large and mobile, terribly fly-bitten ears. Scanning his thin hide, I noticed it was marked by scars. There were bite marks around his rear. Cigarette burns seared his skin. Despite the pain, his mini-marshmallow-shaped stub of a tail began to wag. Once again, his eyes rolled up to me, pleading.

This time, I knew the answer would be, "Yes."

A fence is only a suggestion

I told the lady at the shelter's front desk that I was interested in adopting Shaun. I found out later, that she hid him under her desk to make sure no one spirited him away to the dreaded back room.



After my application was approved, I came back to pick Shaun up. The first thing I discovered once he was home was that he did seem to have lived in a house before. He was housebroken and had good manners. Certainly, it seemed, his life might have started out in a better place before things went so wrong.

We also found out, like many Toy Fox Terriers, he was a canine Houdini. Shaun could escape any fence in the blink of an eye, under, over or through. He is the origin of a cautionary phrase I still use to this day, "To a terrier, a fence is only a suggestion!"

Reaching through the pain

He also had a very scary habit. Whenever he saw a car trunk open, he would jump in and go aggressively ballistic. His eyes would glaze over and he seemed not to even recognize us. A rescue person told me that behavior could come from the horrific practice of using bait dogs to train pit fighters.

Apparently, the "trainer" throws a starved, weak dog into a car trunk with high-value food or a bone. They bring forward the pit dog in training and the smaller, trapped dog feels compelled to fight. If he doesn't, the human might even goad the weaker dog, possibly by burning him with a cigarette.

At this point, I knew I was in over my head with Shaun's occasional outbursts of sudden and severe aggression.

I had never seriously trained a dog before, but I determined that I would now learn how. In addition, I was determined to use some newer techniques that the dog training community was beginning to call, "positive methods".

Shaun had felt enough pain. If I was to reach him and help him become a relaxed, confident and happy dog again, it would have to be through kindness and compassion.

The littlest dog in class

I did find the perfect place and the best mentor to help us on our way. Lisa Ochoa at the Dog Training Club of Champaign-Urbana was an experienced dog training competitor. She also volunteered as a foster home for other various breeds. She not only knew the ins and outs of training, but she also came prepared with a generous heart and understood how best to help me help my troubled dog find his way.

I wrote this poem to commemorate his first day at dog training school.

The Littlest Dog in Class

A little dog stood by the classroom door
shaking and quite shy.
No one had seen him there before.
The littlest dog in class.



He stood and stretched up on his toes
to receive his training collar
Could he make it do you suppose?
The littlest dog in class.

Some dogs are big.
Some dogs are strong.
Some stoutly stand apart.
But one brave hero
always steals my heart.
The littlest dog in class.

My little spotted hero

If there's one thing about Toy Fox Terriers as a breed. They're resilient. With an American legacy that spans from being beloved family members to quick and agile farm dogs to clever circus and stage performers, they are a breed that understands how to roll with whatever life brings them.

Shaun was the same. With time, his body healed. He could jump straight up so high that I often found him staring me in the face as I walked to the table with a plate of food.

On the agility field, he was a flashy jumper. Those long legs could take up a great deal of yardage and fast! He did have his challenges, though. He still was shy, and he was an infamous sniffer. Too bad they didn't have nosework in those days!

But together we made progress from training classes, to earning a CGC, and eventually into the agility, obedience and rally rings. Shaun was one of my best canine teachers. I learned so much from my spotted canine athlete. I still rely on those lessons today.

Making firsts in rally

Where Shaunie really came into his own was in rally obedience. He loved working close to me; he loved getting treats, and his moves were quick and accurate. His fast sits once won him a run-off for a rally High in Trial

We were especially proud when he earned the very first Toy Fox Terrier AKC Rally Novice and Rally Excellent titles!

Shaun was also one of the first Toy Fox Terrier AKC agility titlists. I believe he was the fourth Toy Fox Terrier to earn an Open Agility title.

An agility picture of his was featured in Dr. John Davidson's classic breed book, [The Toy Fox Terrier, Wired for Action](#).



Dog attacks in competition

Shaunie had a shyness around big dogs that understandably lingered after his rescue. He was the shy, skinny kid that the big kids would bully when they were under stress, say, in an obedience lineup for stays. While going for his AKC Companion Dog (CD) title, larger dogs got up from their places and pushed him from his position. On the third leg, a Great Dane laid on on him! Judges allowed him to repeat his stays because the breaks weren't his fault, and he ended up earning one of the first Toy Fox CD titles. But needless to say, I decided competition obedience might not be safe for him. We moved on to agility and rally.

Losing a good friend twice

Later in life, he experienced a very serious attack. While at a dog club for an event, a Standard Poodle swerved over at the end of an unattended leash and grabbed Shaun by the neck. It happened faster than a human can move or react. He shook my poor old guy, and Shaun's face transformed into a mask of ugly rage. It was possibly a reaction he learned in his past, violence-filled life. Startled by that shift, the Poodle's jaw went slack and he dropped Shaun on the floor.

Unfortunately, that experience left injuries that damaged Shaun for the rest of his life. Ever after, he seemed to be in a state of dementia. His eyes were glazed, and he walked like a zombie. His aggression returned and he wouldn't let me near him. He seemed to blame me for the attack.

I can't describe how devastating it was to have gone with Shaun on such a long and hopeful journey only to lose my old friend while he was still with us.

As time passed, though, fate gave me an ironic last gift. As Shaun's dementia progressed, it reached a point where Shaun forgot the tragedy he blamed me for.

In the end, he once again became my dear friend. Isn't it funny and sad how life works sometimes?

Saying goodbye

Shaun passed away at the age of 17. He had a good long life for a terrier. His body still was strong, but his mind continued to fail. He'd gone blind and could no longer hear.

One day, Shaun began to have seizures. Veterinarians say that seizures that begin in old age are often a sign of a serious health problem. Shaun had been through so much in his life, that we couldn't bear for him to suffer anymore.

We helped him cross the bridge on July 21, 2014. It was one of the most peaceful passings I've ever attended.

The last thing I remember is those huge, clear eyes rolling up to me -- just like they had on the first day I saw him years before.



Once again, I had to say, "Yes."

To this day, I can still remember the feel of his smooth coat. I still know the shape and location of every spot. I can feel the turn of every angle and see those big, brown, luminous eyes.

And isn't that the way of every good dog? They never really leave us. As long as they remain in our memory, they are here.

Thank you to the American Toy Fox Terrier Club and Chris Bowker for inviting me to write Shaun's story for the club publication. Writing this has brought him back to life for me if only in my memory.

This article is dedicated to the memory of Lisa Ochoa, who was our first teacher and one of the best.

Barbara Scanlan began training agility 20 years ago with a rescue Toy Fox Terrier. Since then, she's gone on to train and compete with four charming and talented Papillons. She's achieved many agility titles and championships with her dogs, including the AKC Preferred National Agility Championship (PNAC) and a regional AKC Premier Cup. 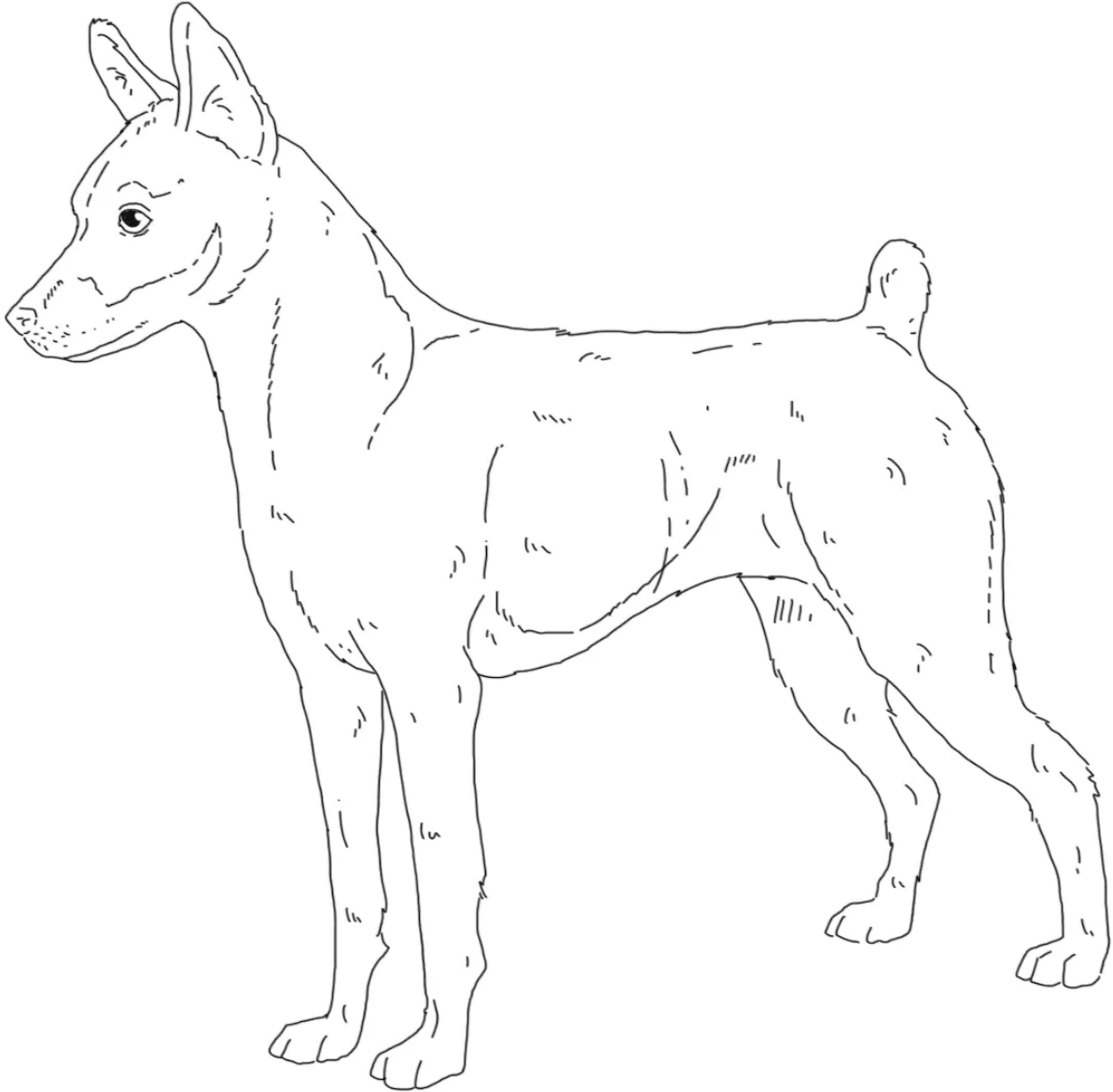

Code of Ethics

Code of Ethics of American Toy Fox Terrier Club:

The ATFTC's constitution requires its members to do all in their power to protect and to advance the interests of the breed. To that end I agree to abide by the provisions below, which apply to my particular circumstances either as an owner or as a breeder.

I agree that as an owner of Toy Fox Terrier(s) I will:

Follow the "Golden Rule" in that I will do unto others as I would have done unto me in all dog enterprises.

Always endeavor, with regards to my Toy Fox Terrier, to act in a courteous and responsible manner, which includes keeping my Toy Fox Terrier under control at all times, cleaning up after my Toy Fox Terrier and trying to leave public places we frequent in a better condition than we found them.

Be familiar with and abide by the rules of the American Kennel Club.

Consider the welfare of Toy Fox Terriers above personal gain/profit.

Be honest with others in all my representations about my Toy Fox Terrier, including issues of appearance and health.

I agree that as a breeder of Toy Fox Terriers I will:

Produce litters only to improve the breed and when adequate care can be provided in raising and placing the pups.

Always consider the age, health and well-being of the bitch in making my breeding decisions, including frequency and number of breedings.

Never breed a bitch before she is one year old and sufficiently mature.

Keep accurate breeding records and pedigrees, and aid in the prompt registration of all puppies in accordance with all applicable rules and regulations.



Offer a written agreement of sale to all puppy purchasers, reserving the right to provide a "Limited Registration".

Place puppies with new owners only after I am convinced that the buyer will provide responsible and humane care.

To the best of my ability, help re-home any puppies or dogs of my breeding should any occasion arise indicating that this assistance is needed.

Advertise honestly.

Not be a party to the breeding of Toy Fox Terrier for sale to "wholesalers", or to commercial distributors of any description, including research laboratory facilities.

Breed only healthy stock, free of genetic defects, transmittable diseases, unsound behavior, such as unwarranted aggression or shyness towards humans.

Provide stud dog services only to bitches registered with the American Kennel Club, or kennel clubs recognized by the AKC.

Act in a responsible and helpful manner to all of my puppy owners.

Encourage permanent identification, such as tattoo or microchip.

Be honest with respect to the health, conformation and disposition of all my Toy Fox Terrier, dams, sires and offspring.

Acknowledgment and Agreement:

As a condition of membership in the American Toy Fox Terrier Club, I hereby acknowledge that I have read and understood this Code of Ethics. I accept this Code in its entirety, and I agree to be bound by it. I agree further, that membership in the ATFTC is a privilege, not a right, and that violations of this Code by me, may results in disciplinary action, up to the including the expulsion from the Club, consistent with Article VI of the Club's By-Laws.
