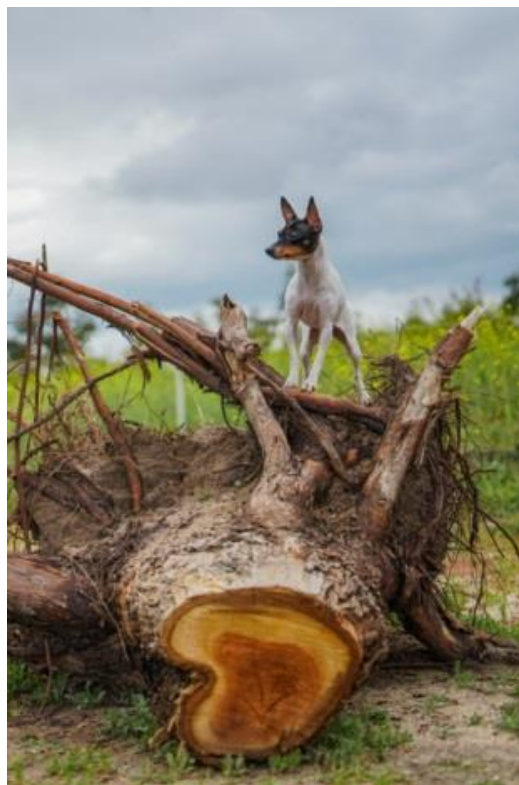

Message from the Editor

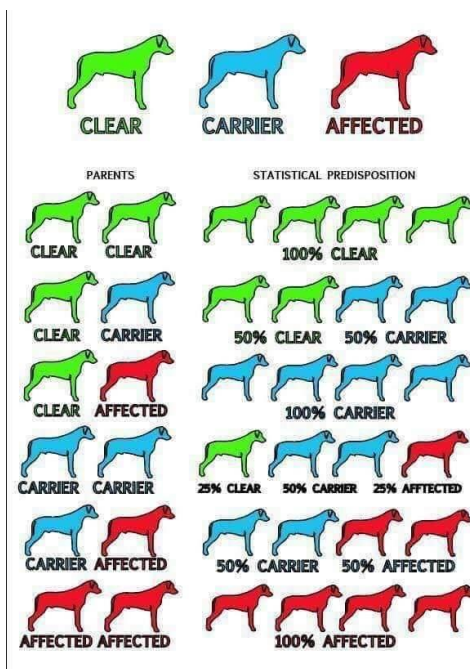

HOW MANY YEARS HAVE YOU BEEN INVOLVED IN THE DOG SPORT(S): 40 years (yikes)

WHEN WERE YOU FIRST DRAWN TO TOY FOX TERRIERS, AND WHAT SPARKED THAT ATTRACTION: Toy Fox Terriers were the Lichty's family dog. They lived on Chipper Avenue in Wichita, KS and Chipper was the tft's name. When AKC in 2002 recognized the breed it was a natural breed for downsizing from our years showing and breeding Standard Poodles. I loved poodles and think it might have been that their carriage and build is like that of Saddle Bred Horses.

HOW MANY LITTERS A YEAR DO YOU HAVE AND WHAT WAS YOUR MOST SUCCESSFUL LITTER: We maybe breed a litter every two years when we have requests from other homes and when we are ready for new dogs to show. I am proud of finding a strong sire that produced Ch. Guitar Shorty and his sister Ch. Accolade Pieces of Eight. Now we have a Shorty litter of 3 champions. Two of which had nice wins at the 2019 ATFTC National Specialty and a third from the litter finished as well. It is nice to have dogs that can produce well bred to another quality dog. That proves your program. I am grateful to good breeders whose dogs contributed to our line.

IN WHAT VENUE(S) DO YOU COMPETE: We always have competed in AKC with the standard poodles and in the past in Canada in CKC.

GREATEST THRILLS IN THE DOG GAME: We love producing puppies that go on to complete championships and are dear to their owners. We like nice things and dogs bred to the standard produce beautiful, sound dogs.

WHAT FEATURE(S) OF THE TOY FOX TERRIER DO YOU FEEL NEEDS THE MOST IMPROVEMENT: The whole dog needs to be considered from correct conformation and movement to temperament and health. The judges I was mentoring during the National Specialty in Orlando laughed but agreed when I answering this question by saying, "The fronts and the rears." It is true that if we could take the best from each dog we might make the perfect one.

ANY OTHER INTERESTS ASIDE FROM TFTS YOU MAY HAVE: We love travel and enjoy live performances from Santana to Carmen. We have been active in the local kennel club and have served on the board as officers and board members as well as on many show committees. The

same can be said for the ATFTC. It's important to give back to the sport to keep it going. Clubs depend on volunteers and your local all breed is the best place to get experience.

OTHER ANIMALS/LIVESTOCK: As a young person Carolyn had horses. We have had cats and several breeds of dogs including an English Cocker, an English Setter, a Cairn Terrier as well as Standard and Toy Poodles

HOBBIES/TALENTS: Rick plays golf and we enjoy going out to dinner.

YOUR BUSINESS OR JOB: Carolyn has been a teacher of Art and English, a dog groomer, a handler, a breeder and some boarding

Should I Be Testing For Spinocerebellar Ataxia (SCA)?

Well, if you ask me, you **SHOULD** be testing all your breeding dogs for SCA or know if your dogs are clear by parentage. If you are armed with test results, you can easily manage a carrier by only breeding it to a TFT that has been tested clear for the condition. I had carriers in my TFT pack before I knew SCA was an issue within the breed. I had no idea because, luckily, I had bred them to clear studs, and hadn't produced any puppies with the condition. A few years back when I heard from another breeder that SCA was a condition showing up in TFTs, I decided to test all my breeding dogs at that time for the condition. One of the TFTs I tested was my lovely bitch, LuLu, also known as *DynAsty Valcopy Easy on the Eyes*. Since I had not produced a dog with the condition, I expected my dogs to all come back with the word "Clear" printed on their results. Well, that was not the case. LuLu came back as a carrier for SCA. I continued to be able to use LuLu in my small breeding program because I had her test results and could make educated breeding decisions for her. Since that time, I have kept one of LuLu's daughters who is also a SCA carrier. Toy Fox Terriers have such a small gene pool, so I would encourage ALL TFT breeders to test for SCA, but not to place or discontinue using their SCA carriers. A carrier with a lot of good qualities who is otherwise a healthy dog, can be an asset to your breeding program.

What is Spinocerebellar Ataxia (SCA)

According to OFA's website, "The term cerebellum in Latin means "the little brain." The cerebellum is the part of the brain responsible for coordinating movements. Ataxia comes from a Greek term meaning "without order". When the cerebellum cannot coordinate movement, the dog can move, but the movement is poorly coordinated. They are not weak, in fact, often the movements a dog with ataxia makes are too strong. They have a goose-stepping gait and when excited or running, their legs may appear to be going every which-way. Sometimes they have problems with their balance and will fall frequently. In order for the cerebellum to control movement, it needs to get feedback about what the muscles are doing. This feedback comes to the brain through the spinal cord. When there are changes in the spinal cord in a dog with cerebellar ataxia, the disease is often called spinocerebellar ataxia (SCA)." This information was taken from the OFA website (www.ofa.org). Testing for SCA can be done through OFA as well as many other Animal Testing Labs.
