Judging The Toy Fox Terrier With An Undocked Tail

From the American Toy Fox Terrier Club, Inc. (ATFTC) (Adopted by the Board of Directors on August 14, 2019)

The Toy Fox Terrier is a docked breed. The AKC Breed Standard states “The tail is set high, held erect and in proportion to the size of the dog. Docked to the 3rd or 4th joint.”

The ATFTC continues to support docked tails as an important characteristic required by the breed's function for this breed is not just a toy but is a terrier with a history rooted in hunting rats and other vermin. Therefore, the ATFTC does not intend to change the breed standard as regards docked tails.

In accordance with A.K.C. rules (Chapter 7, Section 15), A judge’s decision shall be final in all cases affecting the merits of the dogs. Full discretionary power is given to the judge to withhold any, or all, prizes for want of merit. If in the judge’s mind the deviation from the standard affects the merit of the dog, it is the prerogative of the judge to withhold any prizes from the animal.

Additionally, in May, 2012, the A.K.C. also issued the following statement: Individual Examination of Dogs. Judges are expected to examine and gait every dog in the same objective, breed-specific manner even if a poor specimen may clearly be out of the ribbons. This includes breeds that according to their breed standard traditionally have been cropped and/or docked and dogs entered which may have deviations from the breed standard.

The ATFTC will support your decision to withhold awards on an undocked dog after it has been examined and gaited.

Should you choose to keep a Toy Fox Terrier with an undocked tail in the ring, it is expected that you would prioritize your judging by virtues. The undocked tail carriage should also be a direct extension of the docked tail standard. The tail should be carried erect, never curled or laying over the back and in proportion to the body, with no kink or deformity.

As the Toy Fox Terrier has always been and should continue to be a docked breed, determine the tail set and carriage of an undocked tail by observing the tail through the 3rd or 4th joint as the dog is being moved.

2020 National Topic of Discussion Only

Floor was turned over to Carolyn to discuss options for National

Carolyn shared having a Designated Specialty like we had this year in Lexington having classes with the All-Breed Show. Involves the fewest number of committee members and probably the least expensive. Our cost was ribbons, rosettes, trophies, decorations.

She then shared having a Concurrent Specialty has two classes for Toy Fox Terriers on the same day plus a sweepstakes. It's as if we have an independent show and we have to hire the superintendent which Onofrio is the superintendent for the Oklahoma cluster. Their basic fee is \$75.00 plus \$6.50 for each dog entered which Carolyn estimates to end up being about \$465.00. Cluster panel would charge us \$5/entry for using one of their judges otherwise we would be responsible for all the expense of judge. Ring setup would be provided by cluster, we would buy ribbons and trophies. We would probably need to provide a ring steward.

Biggest cost difference would be in the cost of judge – whether we choose to use one of the judges already coming to the cluster or bring in a different one. Plus we have our own superintendent and catalog expenses if we chose to have our own. It was suggested by Cindy we not have our own catalog but encourage advertising in the catalog put together by the cluster to get more coverage.

It is Time to Hold a Toy Fox Terrier Agility Specialty!

Warning: very biased opinion follows!

I have 3 Toy Fox Terriers who compete in Agility. All of them are AKC registered and a product of a well known breeder. We trial across the country because we have a goal of running in an AKC agility trial in all 50 states. So far, we have completed 40 states.

At many of these trials, there are numerous other Toy Foxes entered. It is a delight to meet the teams and we connect on Facebook etc. to stay in touch. Invariably, sometime during the trial, the conversation turns to “why don’t we have a national specialty like nearly every other breed does?” Hold that thought.

According to AKC, 34 Toy Foxes have achieved at least 1 MACH title and 4 have earned at least one PACH title. [PACH indicates the dog runs at a “preferred height”, 4” lower than he actually measures for but all other requirements are the same.] To be a MACH or PACH dog, the team must demonstrate a high level of technical expertise and consistency. It is not easy to qualify in both Master Standard and Master Jumpers on the same day, **20 times** and have 750 points. Points are awarded per second under Standard Course Time on each qualifying run. At the Master Level, the run must be perfect to qualify. So, all it takes is Perfection, Consistency and Speed.

As of mid-year 2019, the **#3 Overall Agility Dog (all breeds, all jump heights)** is none other than MACH 15 Icefox Pick Me Up “Gigolo” trained and handled by Mary Doyle of Illinois. He is the #2 Overall Dog in the 8” jump height. Take a minute to let that sink in. I don’t know what that would correspond to in the Conformation world, but please be impressed by this.

Our little dogs work hard to learn the skills and understand the directions they get from the handler to run each course. They never see the course until they go to the start line. The handler is given 8 minutes to walk the 18-20 obstacles to decide on the best strategy just 5 minutes before the class starts. Then, all they have to do is be perfect and fast.

There has been conversation on many levels about having a TFT Agility Specialty. People have volunteered to organize it and been denied permission to do so. It is time to make this happen and bring together all the TFT teams to showcase this aspect of Toy Fox performance and to be recognized by the national club. The people pictured below, are hoping you will hear their voice.

Follow up to Agility Article

How can the ATFTC hold an agility trial?

First let me say I would love to see another trial hosted by the ATFTC.

For those of you who don't know me let me clarify my background a bit. My wife and I trial TFTs in agility and many other performance events, as well as showing in conformation.

We are very active in an AKC obedience club here in Northern Illinois and I am honored to be the president of that club. Our club leases a 20,000 sq. foot building in which we hold 12 days of agility trials every year. We also rent our space to other clubs in the area.

I tell you this so you know I am familiar with what it would take for the ATFTC to host a trial. The first way would be to rent a facility; our club gets \$850 for a two day weekend, and there are additional charges for using our timers, sound system and video system. Once you find a place, you need AKC approval and you will have to hire a trial secretary. Then you need to secure a judge and that will probably involve travel, lodging and food expenses. Next you need 25-30 experienced volunteers, course builders, scribes, bar setters, gate stewards, etc. Many clubs give volunteers free or reduced entries. Do not forget the need to feed volunteers and judges. There is also the expense of ribbons and any prizes. With all this, you must have five members of the ATFTC present on site during the trial.

You can see this gets pretty complicated and expensive. The other way would be to allow an approved club to use some of the 12 days allotted to the ATFTC.

Normally the club actually putting on the trial pays the club who has allowed the use of their days a typically small fee, paid by the entry. A down side to doing it this way is that the home club usually keeps the best days for themselves. Many clubs are willing to add a Monday or Friday to their own Saturday and Sunday trial. Friday and Monday trials do not always draw as well. Again, you would need to have five ATFTC members on the site.

I'm not saying it can't be done, but it takes many people working together to make an agility trial work. The biggest problem is club members doing agility with their TFTs are scattered all around the USA. It can be hard to find the right time and right place for enough people to make this work.
